Today we:

Played long, even tones on first note E

Learnt the music letter names ABCDEFG

Learnt to read some music using E and one count notes and rests

Play piece with backing track on note E, using tonguing.

Explored new notes D and C

This week:

Aim to try your clarinet at 4-7 times before the next lesson.

Ask a parent to help you put it together

When you practise still play long, even sounds – trying to make your best sound.

Practise tonguing repeated E D and C and make up your own tune using E D and C

Before next lesson:

On next week's sheet there will be a website link to music to play along with. Check you have a computer or tablet and some speakers or headphones so you can see and hear the music

Remember to keep trying, **play a little and often**. Look after your clarinet, especially the reed.
